- **1. CHANGE ENGINE OIL AND FILTER**
- **2. INSPECT AIR CLEANER AND SERVICE AS REQUIRED**
- **3. CHANGE PRIMARY CHAINCASE LUBRICANT AND CLEAN THE MAGNETIC DRAIN PLUG. CHECK AND ADJUST PRIMARY CHAIN***
- **4. VERIFY CLUTCH ADJUSTMENT**
- **5. CHANGE TRANSMISSION LUBRICANT AND CLEAN MAGNETIC DRAIN PLUG**
- **6. CHECK AND ADJUST DRIVE BELT**
- **7. INSPECT BRAKE PADS AND ROTORS FOR WEAR**
- **8. CHECK BRAKE FLUID LEVELS AND CONDITION**
- **9. INSPECT ALL HYDRAULIC AND OIL LINES FOR LEAKS**
- **10. LUBRICATE AND INSPECT ALL CABLES, HAND CONTROLS, FOOT CONTROLS AND JIFFY STAND**
- **11. INSPECT FUEL SYSTEM FOR LEAKS AND PROPER OPERATION**
- **12. CHECK TIRE WEAR, PRESSURE, AND TREAD DEPTH**
- **13. CHECK TIGHTNESS OF ALL SPOKES***
- **14. CHECK STEERING HEAD ADJUSTMENT**
- **15. CHECK FRONT END FOR PROPER OPERATION, ADJUSTMENT AND LEAKS**
- **16. CHECK OPERATION OF ALL ELECTRICAL EQUIPMENT AND SWITCHES**
- **17. CHECK BATTERY CONDITION AND CONNECTIONS**
- **18. CHECK CHARGING SYSTEM OUTPUT**
- **19. CHANGE SPARK PLUGS**
- **20. CHECK AIR SUSPENSION***
- **21. LUBRICATE HINGES, LATCHES, FUEL DOOR, TOUR PAK, AND SADDLEBAGS***
- **22. CHECK STABILIZERS AND ENGINE MOUNTS***
- **23. VERIFY HEADLAMP ADJUSTMENT**
- **24. CHECK ALL CRITICAL FASTENERS**
- **25. INSPECT COOLING SYSTEM FOR LEAKS, COOLANT LEVEL AND CONDITION, RADIATOR(S) FREE OF DEBRIS**
- **26. CHECK FOR ECM CALIBRATION AND/OR AUDIO SYSTEM UPDATES**
- **27. ROAD TEST**
- **28. CLEAN MOTORCYCLE**

Perform recommended services every 5000 miles according to your Harley-Davidson service manual.

Higher mileage Services may require additional procedures that may affect cost of service. Our service Department will advise you at time of appointment if additional procedures are necessary. For Example: Front fork rebuild, steering stem bearings, fuel filter, inner primary bearing, cam chain tensioners, and wheel bearings.
